155 Plastic cups were removed... 91 Plastic lids were removed...

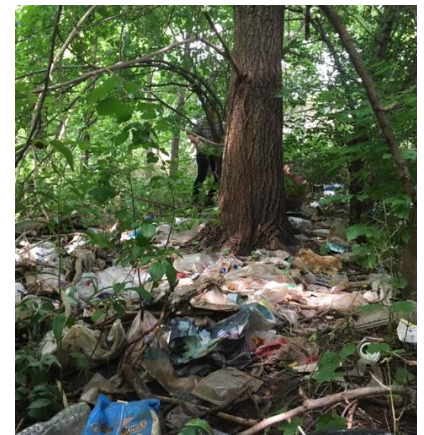
88 Beverage cans were removed...

388 Plastic bottles were removed...

148 Bottle caps were removed...

91 Containers were removed...

36 Pieces of paper were removed...

11 Tiles were removed...

13 Metal pieces were removed...

141 Plastic bags were removed...

20 Glass bottles were removed...

19 Utensils were removed...

1 Blanket was removed...

9 Clothing/shoes were removed...

2 metal poles were removed...

...all from an 1 hour long clean-up.

As well as 2 batteries, 1 cigarette butt, 10 pieces of foil, 1 pair of glasses, 4 perfume bottles, 5 lighters, 1 pair of scissors, 1 clock, 1 balloon, 2 ribbons, 1 mask, 2 strings of beads, and 1 tire pump were removed...
